Freed from
Pharaoh and Egypt

Unleavened Bread

Israel's Example

- Plundered the Egyptians
- Exodus from Egypt in haste
- "Baptized" in the Red
[Reed] Sea

- Travel to Mount Sinai
- Israel “tested”
- Covenant at Mount Sinai

Israel's Example

“1st” Coming of Jesus Christ

- Born at the appointed time
[Galatians 4:4](#)
- Born of the Holy Spirit [breath,
[John 20:22](#), [Genesis 2:7](#)] as the 2nd
Adam ([1 Corinthians 15:45](#))
- The coming of the Messiah was
anticipated
- Easier to see why there was
confusion about the nature of His
“1st” coming – and why we may be
confused about His next coming

Atonement

Israel's Example

- Corresponds to the Passover “Season”
- Though both were fulfilled at the cross, Atonement was fulfilled separately from the Passover
- “Note” of Atonement with “Note” of Passover on different “levels” or “octaves” in a scale creates a “chord”
- “Afflict your souls” ([Leviticus 16:29](#), connection - [Mark 2:18-20](#)) vs “bread of affliction” ([Deuteronomy 16:3](#))
- Basis for LATER application, after Christ ascends to The Father as our High Priest and the Holy Spirit is made available:
 - Jesus Christ learned submission through His suffering. [Hebrews 5:7-9](#)
 - Curtain torn, opening access to Most Holy Place & Mercy Seat ([Hebrews 9:7](#))
 - Covering of Sin ([Romans 4:6-8](#))
 - Putting away Satan ([James 4:7](#), [John 12:31](#))

Tabernacles

Israel's Example

- Recognize the passing away of the temporary old covenant [Hebrews 8:13](#)
- In addition to the temporary tent, even the two “permanent” temples ended up being temporary [Matthew 24:2](#)
- Corresponds to the Week of Weeks on the “historic timeline”
- Christ revealed Himself in the Old Testament on the “historic timeline” and how it pointed FORWARD to Him [Luke 24:27-48](#)
